HOW TO REGISTER

1. Register online at: <http://olympichillspta.org/afterschool> **OR** complete the attached registration form.
Pick ONE class per student per day. (*You do not have to register for both days*).
Use a different form for each student.
2. Return the registration forms to your student's teacher or the main office by **Monday, March 18th**.
Only completed forms can be processed.
3. The PTA will notify you on March 26th if your student has a spot in an after school class.
4. If your student gets in a class, we will send you a bill on March 26th.
****Please DO NOT send money with the registration form.****
5. Some scholarships are available. If you need a scholarship, please mark that on the registration form. Because of generous donations and grants, the PTA is able to offer some 50% and 100% scholarships. If you can pay the full amount, please do so. It will help us continue to provide educational, fun, and engaging after school classes for all students. Additional donations are always appreciated. Thank you.

CLASS ENROLLMENT

Class sizes are limited. All forms received by **Monday March 18th**, will be processed by lottery and not first-come-first served basis. Late forms will be considered only if space is available. We cannot guarantee a class for siblings.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS - SPRING 2019

MONDAY CLASS OPTIONS:

LEARN TO RIDE BIKE CLUB

Grades K-5, FEE: \$20

Spend Spring learning how to ride a bike! We'll practice balance, pedaling, safety, and the skill of bike riding that lasts a lifetime! We provide a new helmet for all students, and a bike to use if needed. *(Class limit: 12 students)*

NATURE CLUB

Grades K-2, FEE: \$20

Come explore nature in our school yard! Discover how animals survive in their habitats and learn the Water Cycle Boogie! This is a great introduction to our natural world and the plants and animals that we share it with. We'll be learning both inside and outside the school. *(Class limit: 15 students)*

JOURNALISM

Grade 5, FEE: \$20

Let's put out a school newspaper! In this after school journalism class we will brainstorm what should go in our newspaper, assign stories, conduct interviews, practice our news and opinion writing, and lay out our news (and comics! and advertisements! and games! and opinions!) into a newspaper format to distribute to our classmates. *(Class limit: 12 students)*

BASKETBALL

Grades K-2, FEE: \$90

Join One on One Basketball for After School Hoops®. Our experienced and positive instructors will teach your child athletic fundamentals through proven drills, fun competitions and controlled scrimmaging. *(Class limit: 18 students)*

TUESDAY CLASS OPTIONS:

CREATIVE CODING

Grades 3-5, FEE: \$189

Make the games you want to play! Build a game to learn the basics of Scratch, plus all about **conditionals**, **variables**, **debugging**, and more. Then level-up your skills and bring your own ideas to life! Every class, the teacher will give new challenges or help you to craft the project you have in your imagination. *(Class limit: 14 students)*

SKATEBOARDING

Grades 3-5, FEE: \$35

Let's rip! All genders are welcome to join us to shred after the bell with Afterschool Skateboarding Club. Instructors from local non-profit, Skate Like a Girl, will lead youth through the basics of pushing and riding, moving on to tricks like "ollies" and more as the weeks progress! All gear provided - helmet, pads, skateboard. *(Class limit: 15 students)*

COLORING CLUB

Grades K-2, FEE: \$20

Coloring Club is a fun way for your to relax and enjoy the fun world of coloring! Each week we will focus on a different color concept or artist while your children get to express their artistic selves. *(Class limit: 15 students)*

CHESS CLUB

Grades 2-5, FEE: \$70

Chess is a game that fosters intellectual growth while having fun. Students learn the basic rules of the game and begin to learn strategies for capturing the king. It is a game that exercises both sides of the brain, increases creativity, and improves memory. *(Class limit: 16 students)*
